

Volunteer Committee

The month of March has blessed the Cove with blue skies, cool breezes/wind, green grass, hummingbirds, budding trees, AND more shore exposed on Giblin's Pond! Do we want shore exposed on Giblin's Pond? Yes... if we want the pond dam to continue to hold back the water! Did you know that only 10 years ago the damn was virtually clear of trees? The tallows have quickly taken hold...and we are quickly taking them down. Why? Because the Tallow roots will compromise the earthen dam.

The Volunteer Committee worked 2 Saturdays this Month. We had 14 people on Volunteer Saturday, and 8 folks on March 22, as the tallows were finally ready for cutting and treating with a herbicide. The clearing because of some very hard-working volunteers have made much progress in front of the pond and moving onward down the dam. At our next Volunteer Saturday, we will continue to move down the dam. Diligence will be necessary in watching and treating new growth, as this will be a process over time.

Neighbors are telling me stories of times spent at the pond with their children and grandchildren, and the memories are told with a smile. Perhaps you also have wonderful memories of quiet times watching the ducks, or enjoying the shimmering rays on the water, or watching your children catch a fish. The pond is an asset and truly a gem. Consider joining us in the work, and one day you can say to the next generation.... I helped save the pond 😊 and in the process of helping you will meet some wonderful people.
