

COUNTRYSHIRE HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION POOL INFORMATION 2024 SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

In case of vandalism, equipment malfunction, or operations problems, please contact Your HOA Management Team at 916-833-5250.

If there is a problem with pool staff, please contact Unique Pool Management at 314-455-6350.

The Association reserves the right to make changes to the pool rules as it deems necessary for the protection and benefit of Association Members and their guests. All Members are expected to discuss the rules and regulations with their guests and children.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The pool season starts the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend and ends the Monday of Labor Day weekend.

Daily hours are 9am-9pm.

****If and when lifeguards are not on duty all swimming is at your own risk.****

Any resident with a balance on their HOA account will not have access to the pool.

Two (2) pool fobs are provided for each household and reused each year. If lost or stolen, it is \$25/fob to receive a replacement. **DO NOT SHARE FOBS!** If someone (guest or resident) is suspended from the pool for disorderly conduct, the owner of the fob they used to gain access to the pool (or the resident who brought them as a guest) will also be suspended.

Renters must be registered with the community management company to have use of the fobs.

POOL RULES:

1. No dogs or other pets are permitted in the pool area.
2. Children under sixteen (16) years old must be accompanied by an adult eighteen (18) years of age or older.
3. A maximum of four (4) guests per household per visit and only if the Property Owner or Head of Household is present.
4. No glass is allowed on the pool premises.
5. No alcoholic beverages. Anyone deemed intoxicated and disorderly by the Management Staff/Lifeguard will be asked to leave the premises.
6. No cigarettes, drugs, or similar substances are permitted within the pool fence.
7. Only proper swimwear is allowed into the pool. Thong swimsuit bottoms are not permitted. Only swimwear diapers are allowed into the pool.
8. Chairs and lounges are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. There will be no reserving of furniture allowed.
9. No eating or drinking in the water; please keep all snacks on the pool deck.
10. All members are responsible for picking up after themselves. All trash should be disposed of in proper containers.

11. Profanity and/or vulgar remarks are not allowed.
12. Music will be allowed at the discretion of the lifeguard.
13. Only children 5 years of age and younger are allowed to swim in the baby pool with an adult present at all times.
14. Children will only be permitted in the deep-water section of the pool at the lifeguard's discretion. For the safety of the child, the lifeguard may request that the child demonstrate their ability to swim one width of the pool (in good form) and tread water for at least 30 seconds.
15. Do not spit, blow your nose, or place any other bodily fluid or inappropriate matter into the water.
16. Individuals with open wounds, sores, skin infections, bandages, or infectious diseases are forbidden to enter the pool.
17. The parking lot must be vacated when the pool closes. There shall be no overnight parking or loitering in the parking lot.
18. The pool may be closed for maintenance purposes, health conditions, weather, or any reason deemed sufficient by the pool management. There will be no refund of Association fees if the pool is required to be closed for any reason.
19. Damage to pool property is not permitted. Any member who causes such damage shall be held responsible for their, or their guests', actions.
20. Due to the size of the pool area special events, private pool parties, children's birthday parties, and other group get-togethers are not allowed.
21. Pool attendants reserve the right to end any playing or behavior deemed unsafe or considered an annoyance to others.
22. Only authorized pool personnel are allowed on the lifeguard stand and inside the pool office. Do not distract, disturb, or annoy the lifeguard.
23. The association assumes no liability for lost or stolen items so please keep an eye on your belongings.

RULE VIOLATION POLICY:

Violation of any of the Pool Rules by any Member, their children, or guests may result in immediate expulsion from the pool area, fines and/or the loss of pool privileges for a period of time to be determined by the Board of Directors.

Minor infractions will be handled as follows:

1. Pool Staff will provide a verbal warning.
2. Pool Staff will suspend Member's pool privileges for thirty (30) minutes.
3. Pool Staff will suspend Member's pool privileges for the remainder of the day.

Serious or repeated minor violations will be handled by the pool manager. Use or possession of alcohol, illegal drugs, weapons, abusive language or threats of physical violence to members, guests and/or pool staff will be forwarded immediately to the Board. The Board may recommend the manager impose a specific disciplinary action, or the Board may impose that disciplinary action by its own motion. This policy serves as a guideline for the Board of Directors in determining the actions the Association may take in response to violations of the rules, but the Board retains the ability to impose a different penalty using its own discretion after consideration of the circumstances surrounding the violation. If an individual has been suspended from the pool, they may not enter as a guest of another member during the period of their suspension.
